



Faith that Works Part 1 How to Increase Your Faith

Luke 17:5-6, NKJV

- I. First: We have to know and believe our faith can be increased and Jesus wants to teach us how. (2 Corinthians 10:15, NKJV, NLT)**
 - a. If our faith increases the boundaries of the work God's given us will increase.
 - b. God wants our faith to increase. (Luke 17:5-6, KJV)

- II. What we speak to by faith has to respond.**
 - a. Jesus said speak to the problem—We must get the seed (God's Word) into our heart before we can speak it. (Romans 10:8-15, NKJV)
 - b. The heart is referred to as 'soil/ground'—seed falls on good ground it produces whatever seed is planted; if it falls on hard ground it dies and does not reproduce itself.
 - c. The principal of faith –being saved applies to everyone. (Romans 10:16-17, NKJV)

- III. What we seed we will receive: What we sow we will reap.**
 - a. Seeding and receiving is one of the first laws, principles God put into place. (Genesis 1:11-12, NKJV)
 - b. Whatever kind of seed we plant we're going to get more of that type of seed.
 - c. Whatever you need more of you need to start planting those seeds. (Galatians 6:7-10, NKJV)
