Your Story Has To Revolve Around His Glory

1 Corinthians 10:3, NKJV; Revelation 4:11, NKJV

I. Your Story has to revolve around His Glory.

- a. To find your purpose you have to understand “your story has to revolve around His Glory.
- b. Most people, including Christians believe, live, and respond to live in a way that they believe life revolves around their story.
- c. Learning and understanding that your story has to revolve around God’s Glory—what happens to you and around you simply become part of **God’s Story to bring Him Glory!** (1 Peter 4:16, NKJV)
- d. Suffering without glorifying God—makes our suffering senseless, sometimes shameful and sad. (1 Peter 4:16, NKJV)
- e. We all have a God given desire to find God’s purpose for our lives—the problem is most don’t know it or how to do it—so we live our lives for self.
 - i. God’s passion and purpose for our lives is to bring honor and glory to Him.
 - ii. Our passion and purpose is to be satisfied.
 - iii. God is most glorified in us when we are most satisfied in Him. (1 Corinthians 6:20, NKJV)
 - iv. God created us on *Purpose with a Purpose to help accomplish His Purpose.*
 - v. God created us *on Purpose with a Purpose* in a way we *cannot find our Purpose without doing His Purpose.*

II. In order to find our purpose, it has to line up with God’s Purpose.

- a. If you really want to find **God’s purpose** your life has to line up:
 - i. **Physically** – Where you work; how you take care of your body.
 - ii. **Spiritually** – Not just salvation, but ongoing relationship with Jesus Christ.
 - iii. **Financially**- Understanding everything you own, your money, time, talent comes from God and belongs to you.

- iv. **God owns it all**—God created you the way you are with the ability you have, physically, spiritually, and financially.
- b. You will be judged and rewarded based on what God has given you, not what you don't have. (Matthew 25:15, NKJV; Psalm 50:10-12, NKJV; Haggai 2:8-9, NKJV; 1 Chronicles 29:11-12, NIV)
- c. **Everything belongs to the Lord** and as we learn to use our physical, spiritual, and financial ability to bring glory to God—the more we find our purpose and passion.
- d. God's **Most Glorified** when we are the **Most Satisfied**. (1 Chronicles 29:14-16, NIV)
- e. Every good gift—every good thing you have comes from the Lord and belongs to the Lord we are simply managers. (James 1:17, NIV)
- f. **How are you managing your God-given gifts?** (Proverbs 11:28, NIV)
- g. We are going to have problems, but when we are living our life in light our story has to revolve around His Glory—failures are not really failures at all—they are simply part of the story that's going to bring God Glory. (John 16:33, NKJV; Psalm 24:1, NIV)
