## 52 Day Miracle The Prayer That Activated the Miracle

- I. The First Component (Step) that Activates a Miracle is Realizing what the problem is. (Nehemiah 1:4-11, NIV)**
  - a. Until we realize what the problem, we won't see a miracle worked in the problem. (Nehemiah 1:3-4, NLT)
  - b. Nehemiah realized the people he loved was in trouble—they were **living in disgrace** instead of **delivered**—the result they were living **defeated** and **discouraged lives**.
  - c. Do you have loved ones living this kind of defeated life?
  - d. Are you broken hearted over the way they are living and willing to pray, fast, and ask God to use you to help deliver them.
- II. The Second Component (Step) that Activates a Miracle is Recognition. (Nehemiah 1:5, NKJV)**
  - a. Nehemiah recognizes who God is—He confessed with his mouth the greatness of God.
  - b. One of the most powerful parts of a prayer that produces a miracle is to recognize how great and awesome our God is. (Ephesians 3:20-21, NKJV; MSG; AMP)
  - c. God is a Dream Maker (Accomplisher)—He wants us to dream dreams so big only He could bring them about!
- III. The Third Component (Step) that Activates a Miracle is Repentance. (Nehemiah 1:6-7, NKJV; NLT)**
  - a. Nehemiah called it what it was SIN.
  - b. One of the greatest problems when it comes to having a breakthrough with God is we don't own up to our sins and our part in the sin.
  - c. We will never get the breakthrough we need and want until we repent. (2 Chronicles 7:13-15, NKJV; Acts 3:19, NKJV)
- IV. The Fourth Component (Step) that Activates a Miracle is a Reminder. (Nehemiah 1:8-10, NKJV, NLT)**
  - a. One of the most powerful prayers we can pray is to pray God's Promises back to God.
  - b. What bold promise of God do you need Him to answer in your life today?

**V. The Fifth Component (Step) that Activates a Miracle is a Request. (Nehemiah 1:11, NLT; NKJV)**

- a. A request not only to answer our prayers for a miracle, but to answer the prayers of all His people.
- b. A request for favor, anointing and appointed for a special purpose.
- c. When we have God's favor, anointing, and appointing we get His power and presence to accomplish with boldness things that are greater than we are.
